As a condition precedent to foster a horse you promise to abide by the following rules:

1. Veterinarians recommend that all fostered animals be quarantined for 30 days away from other livestock as a precaution.
2. All of the applicant's animals must be up to date on veterinary care, vaccines, and worming before commencement of fostering.
3. All animals fostered remain property of the Adams County SPCA, and we retain all rights to the animal being fostered. If we deem it necessary, the animal can be removed without notice for any reason.
4. The fostering location must be no closer than 2 miles away from the location the fostered animal was seized from and can be no further away from the SPCA than 40 miles.
5. **No animal that is being fostered may be raced, shown, bred, or sold for any reason.**
6. Unless otherwise approved, only 2 horses may be fostered at one location. This will allow for ample attention to each and every horse that has been neglected, abused, or abandoned.
7. All veterinarians must fill out a "Veterinary Approval Form" before handling the animal.
8. Any veterinary care given to the horse on foster must be approved by the Adams County SPCA prior to care. If there is an emergency, immediate care may be given and the foster will notify the SPCA within 24 hours thereafter.
9. The Veterinarian is to communicate with and bill The Adams County SPCA at 11 Goldenville Road Gettysburg, PA 17325, unless other arrangements are made in advance.
10. The Adams County SPCA has the right to review all veterinary bills before payment. If services were performed without approval, The Adams County SPCA is not liable for the charges.
11. If emergency veterinary care is needed due to the negligence of the foster applicant, the foster applicant is responsible for the charges.
12. The fosterer may not ride or attempt to ride any fostered horse until a veterinarian has approved the animal for riding.
13. Fostering from the Adams County SPCA does not assure adoption of any animal.

14. If a foster elects to adopt this or any horse from the Adams County SPCA, there will be an adoption fee.
15. The fosterer will submit weekly updates via e-mail or phone for each animal being fostered. Unless otherwise directed by the Shelter Manager.
16. All animals under your care are to be treated with the utmost respect, dignity and compassion.

The following statements are a release of liability to the Adams County SPCA:

1. The Adams County SPCA is not liable for any illness, injury, or death of animals on applicant's property while an SPCA animal is on the premises.
2. The Adams County SPCA is not liable for any damage done to Fosterer's property by a fostered animal at any time.
3. The Adams County SPCA is not liable for any personal injury to Fosterer, Fosterer's family, or anyone that is on the Fosterer's property at the time a foster animal is in residence.
4. The Adams County SPCA reserves the right to deny anyone at anytime the right to foster an animal for any reason.
